Please note that classes are grouped by related subjects. Some classes may be required to take subsequent classes. These classes are not presented in any particular order, however all classes in a particular grouping will be taught together.

Things with an edge

1. Basic knife, ax and other edged tool safety (required basic class)
2. Sharpening a knife or ax.
3. Using knives, axes, chisels and brace and bits.
4. Throwing knives and axes.

12 Volt Things

1. Basic 12 Volt wiring (required basic class)
2. Calculating loads.
3. Building a 12 Volt wind generator.
4. Solar Power
5. Using lights and wiring from abandoned vehicles.

120 Volt Things

1. Basic 120 Volt wiring (required)
2. Calculating loads.
3. Using a 120/220 Volt generator.
4. Basic electric tool safety (required)
5. Using 120 Volt tools

Basic Woodworking

1. Basic woodworking safety (required)
2. Salvaging/reusing materials.
3. Building a small shed
4. Building boxes and coffins.

4. Cleaning and maintaining firearms.
5. Caching firearms

Heating

1. Heating with wood.
